Greater Detroit District District Conference September 17, 2022

Welcome

District Lay Leader, Ruby Anderson welcomed us to a hybrid (both in-person and on Zoom/Mentimeter) Greater Detroit District Conference at 9:00 A.M. at Big Beaver UMC. Ruby introduced the host pastor, Rev. Dr. Tara Sutton, and introduced the theme: "Serving Gracefully with Unconditional Love."

Opening Remarks, Announcements, and Prayer

Rev. Dr. Tara Sutton thanked her congregation and welcomed the new District Superintendent, Rev. Dr. Darryl Totty to the district. Rev. Sutton offered announcements about the building and announced the District Workshops coming in March, then offered prayer for the day.

Opening Remarks and Call to Order

Rev. Dr. Darryl Totty offered opening remarks, thanking Dr. Sutton and her congregation for their hospitality. He acknowledged all District Superintendents, Lay Leaders, and Staff. He spoke of the importance of using technology to communicate and engage with others. Rev. Totty reviewed the many ways to engage during the conference through Zoom, Mentimeter, and smartphones. He then engaged the audience with a brief training using Mentimeter software, which is used to engage audiences. Mentimeter will be the means by which voting will take place during the conference. Rev. Totty officially called the 2022 Greater Detroit District Conference to order.

Roll Call and Approval of 2021 Minutes

Rev. Darry Totty motioned to approve the minutes from the 2021 District Conference. The minutes were submitted by Recording Secretary Rev. Audrey Mangum. There was no discussion. Rev. Totty called for the vote, which was taken through the Mentimeter application. There was 100% approval. The 2021 District Conference Minutes were approved.

Nomination and Election of District Officers

Rev. Totty presented the Slate and the motion from the Nominations Committee to approve the slate. There was a correction on Wayne Price's name and one person whose name appeared twice for the LSM Board. Cailen Mora's name was corrected to Keylen Mora. Rev. Totty called for the vote: 56 voted yes via Mentimeter, 0 no, and 3 abstentions. The in-person vote was unanimous for approval. The nomination slate was accepted. Those leaders present were asked to rise, and those on Mentimeter were asked to give positive words as Rev. Totty prayed for district leaders. Please see the attached corrected leaders list.

Financial Reports and 2023 Budget

District Treasurer Victor Raybaud reported on the finances from 2021 and 2022. We collected almost 90% of ministry shares in 2021, \$61,510.82, the highest percentage in five years. We are on track to

collect a similar percentage in 2022. We spent 72.8% of the budget in 2021 and have spent 58.8 % as of August 2022. The Justice & Mission Engagement position was turned into two positions, Justice and Mission Engagement and Digital and Social Media Specialist. More dollars were added, making the total budget for these two positions \$64,400. Victor opened the floor for discussion. He explained that the Outreach section of the budget was grouped to allow for greater flexibility among the different ministries (Communications, Hands-4-Detroit, Liberia/Haiti, and Urban Methodist Youth Camp). There were no other questions. Please see the attached budget for all entries. Victor moved for the approval of the 2022 budget. 97% yes, 0 no, 3% abstained. Those present who voted by voice did so with unanimous approval. The 2022 Budget was approved.

District Communications

Rev. Totty announced that a QR code was available that would lead to a Google document to receive contact information from individuals in the district. This would allow the district to quickly communicate directly with individuals via text or SMS. Individuals have the option to opt out of this process.

Hands With Detroit Video and Introduction of Adrienne Trupiano-Stepaniak and Susannah Webber

An informational video was shown by Susanna Weber – Hands-With-Detroit, presenting the Hands With Detroit evet 2022, which will be held on October 1 at Cass Community Social Services. Rev. Neil Davis, Superintendency Committee, introduced two new district staff persons, Susanna Webber, Director of Justice and Mission Engagement, and Adrienne Trupiano-Stepaniak, Digital and Social Media Specialist.

Other Business

Rev. Jon Reynolds informed the district about the Michigan Annual Conference's adoption of the Readers to Leaders Program in 2022. This missional program seeks to raise funds for the education of students in Liberia and to raise funds for the Freedom School Program, which provides after-school educational enrichment for students in low-achievement areas in Michigan during the summer months. Each local church is asked to raise \$600 per year towards these efforts.

Musical Selections

Centro Familia Summer Program children and the French Church brought rousing songs for the inspiration and enjoyment of all.

Introduction of Keynote

Rev. Alicea Williams gave a warm introduction of the new District Superintendent, Rev. Dr. Darryl Totty.

Keynote Presentation

The Keynote Presentation was given by Rev. Dr. Darryl Totty. The Conference theme was "Serving Gracefully with Unconditional Love." The scriptural focus was John 12:34-35. All of us yearn to be loved unconditionally, as Jesus calls us to do. Together, we can use our love to impact the world. Wesley tells us to do as much good as we can, whenever we can. As teachers pour into their children, we should pour into others As a mother is patient with her child, we should be patient with each other, helping each other and not giving up. We should lend a hand where we can, helping each other to survive as a church,

and as a district. The sermon ended with the singing of the song, "I Need You to Survive," by Hezekiah Walker.

Rev. Darryl Totty gave the final prayer and the Plenary Session closed at 11:42 A.M.
