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### It Is Not The Church If It is Not Missional

#### □ What is the "why" of your Mission Ministry from:

- □ The leaderships' perspective
- □ The ministry team members perspective
- The church's perspective

All perspectives are important because they <u>will drive the effectiveness of the</u> <u>ministry.</u>

- □ Leaders'vision & attitude will attract/repel people
- Ministry team members will work together and set the atmosphere that will draw people, or cause people to stay away. Our team at Hope has fun when we're together.
- The Ministry must be aligned and make sure that it is aligned with church leadership and clearly communicate what it is doing and hopes to do.

# It Is Not The Church If It is Not Missional "<u>Alignment</u>"

In my humble opinion, one of the greatest Missionaries that ever lived realized <u>the</u> <u>importance of alignment:</u>

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**Galatians 2:1-2** (NRSVUE) - **2** Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, taking Titus along with me. <sup>2</sup>I went up in response to a revelation. Then I laid before them (though only in a private meeting with the acknowledged leaders) the gospel that I proclaim among the gentiles, **in order to make sure that I was not running, or had not run, in vain.** 

## It Is Not The Church If It is Not Missional "Know What You Are About"

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Agree on your Mission – Keep It <u>Simple</u> & <u>Achievable</u> – Clearly Communicate Your Mission – Make Sure Everyone on the team and in the church knows the mission.
